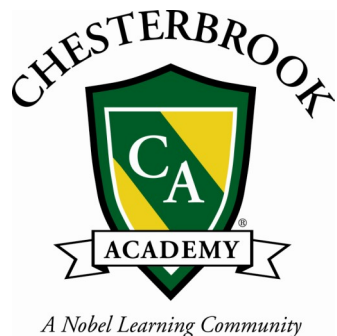

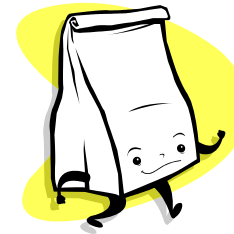

Academic Camp



Two 3-week sessions or one 6-week session are available this year!

Academic Camp is conducted within a small class setting, using a multi-sensory approach to teach reading, spelling and writing. The program builds auditory and visual memory, increases phonological processing, improves writing skills and phonemic awareness, and develops appropriate social, organizational and study skills. Enrollment into the course includes a personalized program plan that will help to pinpoint specific areas in need of improvement for each child. An End-of-Session-Report will highlight areas of progress, and will give educational recommendations outlining the student's academic strengths and weaknesses.

Payment Policy:

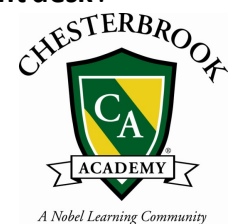
- * A registration fee of \$25 (non-refundable) is required to enroll for summer camp.
- * A deposit of \$325.00, which will pay for your final week of camp, must be paid at the time of registration (non-refundable).
- * By paying the registration fee your child will get a camp t-shirt, water bottle, and cinch bag during their first week.
- * Weekly payments are due on the first day of the week by 9:00am. After 6:00pm on the second day, a \$25 late payment fee will be assessed.
- * Since all camp programs are prescheduled, any changes (additions/deletions) to originally selected programs must be made by FRIDAY-TWO WEEKS IN ADVANCE of requested change. All requests for cancellations made after this deadline will not be accomodated and payment will be required.
