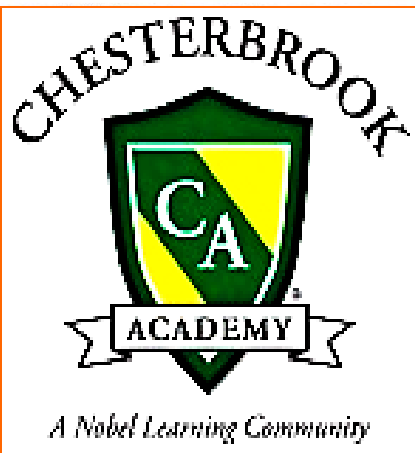

CBA Swim Lessons offer campers a cool, fun, way to learn this summer! In an atmosphere of friendly faces and experienced instructors, your child can feel comfortable in social situations at the pool, learning new skills and improving swim strokes. Becoming a skilled swimmer and knowing how to stay safe in an aquatic environment is extremely important in a young person's life. We'd love to help your child develop a happy and healthy attitude toward the water!

June 29th - July 2nd

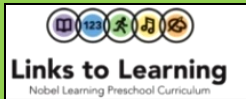
## Week #5
