Weekly Swimming at Marsh Creek

Each week, campers entering Kindergarten and up, head to the swimming pool at Marsh Creek State Park. Campers enjoy a relaxing swim in the near half acre size pool. Our kindergarten & 1st grade campers remain in the shallow end while our 2nd grade & up campers can take a swim test to swim in the deep end. When campers get hungry or thirsty they can purchase a snack from the full-service snack bar.

Campers are supervised by multiple lifeguards as well as by their summer camp counselors.

Campers wear bathing suits to camp on pool days & bring a change of clothes. Campers will need a towel. Goggles are permitted.
